

## Brenner View - Raising the Roof

It's not every day that a banner is raised to the rafters of a school gymnasium. In fact, the last time Riverview held such a ceremony was in 1979, years before any of our students were born. So you can imagine the excitement in Entin Gymnasium a few weeks ago when Riverview celebrated the coed soccer team's undefeated season with a banner raising.

Athletic Director John Benkis planned the event to coincide with a pep rally for athletes leaving for an annual meet in upstate New York. With his trusty bullhorn in hand and enough enthusiasm to shake the foundations of the gym, Mr. Benkis complimented his players and coaches on their teamwork, determination and persistence. He praised them for their sportsmanship and commitment to achieving their personal best. One by one he invited each team member to join him on the court as their peers in the bleachers roared their applause. And finally, to the strains of "We are the Champions," the players grabbed the rope and lifted the banner into the rafters.

Teachers wiped away tears. Student spectators dreamt of a day when they might play on an undefeated team. And all present felt a powerful sense of belonging and of team spirit. It was a morning to remember.

Returning to Janse Hall after the event, I reread a letter that had arrived earlier in the week from a retired public school athletic director who had officiated a basketball game at Riverview. "It was so refreshing to see students playing the game for the fun of it, not concerned about the score

and enjoying the moment," he wrote "I wish all coaches, players, officials, and fans could be exposed to this type of game atmosphere." He requested that his officiating stipend be donated to the School's scholarship fund, adding "I believe that I received so much more from the game than money could buy."

While winning is undoubtedly fun, the most valuable life lessons come from participating. Whether it's in the classroom, auditorium, or out on the playing field, students grow in self awareness, confidence and empathy through immersion in meaningful, age appropriate activities. And they achieve at levels never before anticipated, inspiring teachers and family members in the process.

Such was the case with Karen Hunter, a vibrant, compassionate and fun loving alumna who died this past November, just three weeks before her much anticipated 30<sup>th</sup> birthday. How Karen would have loved the banner raising ceremony! A passionate athlete and



spectator, Karen participated with great gusto in most of Riverview's academic and extra curricular programs during her seven years in East Sandwich. She also endured a seizure disorder, which at one stage required her to wear a helmet. While she hated the helmet, it was the only way she could continue to live her life to the fullest. Karen's young friends, observing her struggle, volunteered to wear helmets as well. While no banner commemorates the achievements of Karen's peers, their actions and the young woman who inspired them will remain in our hearts forever.



## Student Center Update - Amazingly Believable



In 2007, Riverview School officially launched a capital campaign for the new Student Center. The \$9 million goal was the most ambitious in the School's history. The expectation



was that the Student Center would become the signature building for the campus and a spectacular gathering place for current and former students and families. And the hope was to finish the campaign by 2010.

Support for this project was initially strong. The Riverview community clearly understood the transformative effects of this multi

purpose center. But as the summer of 2008 turned into fall, it was clear that the economic landscape had changed. It seemed evident that 2010 was not a realistic timeframe to achieve this dream. And it wasn't.

It was too long! As of March 1st 2009, nearly \$8.5 million has been pledged toward the \$9 million goal. Amazing, but not unbelievable, for at Riverview nothing is impossible! The new hope is to begin construction this coming summer.

The Student Center will provide our students with opportunities never before available. A modern auditorium, creative art classrooms, and a spacious student commons will ensure that the Student Center becomes the hub of our campus for the arts, social activities and community-wide events. At Riverview School, we take great pride in our community, and are especially



grateful for the tremendous support we receive year after year. Thank you!
